- World Fishing Network's willingness to review the submission shall not be construed (and neither party shall hold itself out as being) a partnership, joint venture, or any relationship other than that of independent contractor. Review of the pilot/episode does not guarantee acceptance of the show. It is inappropriate to use the World Fishing Network logo in any sales literature, or sales material, printed or electronic, prior to receiving written notification of an approval.
- If I am notified that the show meets the standards of the channel, I understand that the next step is negotiating fees and airtimes, based on supply and demand.
- I understand that World Fishing Network's sole obligation is to approve or deny the program based on its technical and thematic content, and the channel's need for programming in that particular genre.
- I further understand that any materials submitted will not be returned.

TECHNICAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Programming must be shot and edited on professional equipment, providing audio and video that meets or exceeds the broadcast standards.
- World Fishing Network only accepts programs that are produced and delivered in High Definition.
